

Introduction

At The British Blacklist we are committed to respecting your privacy and protecting your personal data. This privacy policy explains how we will process personal data you provide when you visit our website and other channels, and use our services (together, our "Online Services").

The Online Services are operated by The British Blacklist Ltd, a company incorporated and registered in England and Wales with company number 12672873 whose registered office is at 20-22 Wenlock Road London N1 7GU ("TBB", "we" or "us"). We are a "controller" of your personal data.

How we collect and use your personal data

The table below explains what data we collect, how we use it, and which recipients it might be shared with.

3. COOKIES AND SIMILAR TECHNOLOGIES

A cookie is a text file placed onto your device when you access our Online Services. We use cookies and other techniques such as web beacons, local storage, and flash object storage to deliver, improve and monitor our Online Service:

Authentication To log you in and keep you logged in.

Preferences To remember information about you such as your preferred language.

Analytics To understand how you use our Online Services, so we can improve them. To carry out research and statistical analysis to help improve our content, products and services.

Please note that if you choose to disable cookies, or similar technologies, on your device you may be unable to make full use of our Online Service.

4. DATA SHARING

We will share your information with third parties only in the ways that are described in this privacy policy.

Suppliers and other third parties mentioned in this Privacy Policy: We will disclose personal data to any of the third parties mentioned in this privacy policy, for the purposes set out in this privacy policy. We use [TBC] for our web hosting, Mailchimp for email marketing, and Google analytics services as discussed above, to understand how users make use of our Online Services.

Group members, personnel, suppliers or subcontractors: We keep your information confidential, but may disclose it to any member of our group (which means our subsidiaries, our ultimate holding company and its subsidiaries, as defined in section 1159 of the Companies Act 2006), our personnel, suppliers or subcontractors insofar as it is reasonably necessary for the purposes set out in this privacy policy. However, this is on the basis that they do not make independent use of the information, and have agreed to safeguard it.

Merger or acquisition: If we are involved in a merger, acquisition, or sale of all or a portion of our assets, you will be notified via, account message and/or a prominent notice on our website of any change in ownership or uses of this information, as well as any choices you may have regarding this information.

Required by law: In addition, we may disclose your information to the extent that we are required to do so by law (which may include to government bodies and law enforcement agencies); in connection with any legal proceedings or prospective legal proceedings; and in order to establish, exercise or defend our legal rights (including providing information to others for the purposes of fraud prevention).

Enforcement: We may also disclose your personal information to third parties in order to enforce or apply the terms of agreements, to investigate potential breaches, or to protect the rights, property or safety of us, our customers, or others.

5. INTERNATIONAL TRANSFERS

Where we transfer your information outside of the EEA, we have measures in place to ensure that appropriate safeguards apply to protect your personal data, which may include contracts with those parties which include standard data protection clauses adopted by a data protection regulator and approved by the European Commission. 6. DATA RETENTION

We will only retain your personal data for as long as reasonably necessary to fulfil the purposes we collected it for, including for the purposes of satisfying any legal, regulatory, tax, accounting or reporting requirements. We may retain your personal data for a longer period in the event of a complaint or if we reasonably believe there is a prospect of litigation in respect to our relationship with you.

To determine the appropriate retention period for personal data, we consider the amount, nature and sensitivity of the personal data, the potential risk of harm from unauthorised use or disclosure of your personal data, the purposes for which we process your personal data and whether we can achieve those purposes through other means, and the applicable legal, regulatory, tax, accounting or other requirements. 7. SECURITY

We will take appropriate technical and organisational measures to ensure a level of security appropriate to the risk that could be encountered via the use of our Online Services taking into account the likelihood and severity those risks might pose to the rights and freedoms of our visitors and customers.

In particular, we will take precautions to protect against the accidental or unlawful destruction, loss or alteration, and unauthorized disclosure of or access to the personal data transmitted, stored or otherwise processed by us.

8. YOUR RIGHTS IN RELATION TO PERSONAL DATA

You have certain rights over the way we process personal data relating to you. We aim to comply without undue delay, and within one month at the latest, in response to any requests submitted by you to us:

- for a copy of personal data we are processing about you and/or to have inaccuracies corrected;
- to restrict, stop processing, or to delete your personal data;
- for a machine-readable copy of your personal data, which you can use with another service provider. Where it is technically feasible, you can ask us to send this information directly to another provider if you prefer; and
